In 23 years of dedicated service to the greater East Palo Alto community Free At Last has:

- Graduated over 2,000 clean and sober individuals from our programs
- Reunited hundreds of families
- Conducted prevention and interventions services for individuals regarding HIV/AIDS and substance abuse
- Provided education to individuals, schools, community events and referrals to social services
- Provided 12 Step Meetings in English and Spanish six days a week to thousands of people

During this time period Free At Last has also been a pioneer and leader in the field of substance abuse treatment, criminal justice intervention, and HIV/AID prevention for African Americans and Latinos. Some accomplishments include:

- National model program for the federal government on community-based treatment
- Case study for alternative sentencing legislation in California
